This collaborative artwork celebrates love, passion and teamwork, and captures the city’s unique East-meet-West beauty. It represents a common thread connecting MGM with the community’s past, present and future.

The SKH Ü CARE Moving Care and Service Shuttle project is a mobile speech therapy program for students with special education needs, which alleviates the space, time, geographical or family constraints of needy students and ensures they can receive professional language training and assessment.

The ceremony also recognized community service excellence with MGM Volunteer Award Presentation to Ann Fong and Kelly Lei from Casino Operation and Pang Kuok Wai from Security & Safety. The event was concluded with an inclusive performance, games and lucky draw.
