14 Describe the organizational action and, if applicable, the date of the action or the date against which shareholders' ownership is measured for the action ▶ Healthpeak Properties, Inc. (the "Company") paid quarterly cash distributions on its common stock in excess of its current and accumulated earnings and profits. On January 17, 2023, the Company determined that a portion of each of these distributions represents a return of capital to the shareholders. Consequently, each shareholder that received a cash distribution would be affected by this organizational action. Payment dates and corresponding common distribution amounts were as follows: 02/22/2022 (\$161,791,286); 05/20/2022 (\$161,867,146); 08/19/2022 (\$161,874,431); 11/18/2022 (\$161,263,193).

15 Describe the quantitative effect of the organizational action on the basis of the security in the hands of a U.S. taxpayer as an adjustment per share or as a percentage of old basis ▶ The distributions reduced the basis of the security in the hands of U.S. taxpayers as indicated on the attached schedule.

16 Describe the calculation of the change in basis and the data that supports the calculation, such as the market values of securities and the valuation dates ▶ Healthpeak Properties, Inc.'s earnings and profits were calculated under IRC §312 as modified by §857(d) for Real Estate Investment Trusts. Distributions to common shareholders in excess of earnings and profits reduce each shareholder's tax basis in its shares.
