This donation of supplies intends to strengthen the anti-epidemic measures for daycare centers, primary and secondary schools as well as elderly activity centers of the Society when their services resume. It also provides extra protection to the medical personnel of their clinics and Chinese pharmacies, so that they can serve our citizens in a safe manner.
