



MGM and FAOM Join Hands to Introduce Technical and Vocational Education School – Enterprise Cooperation

Internship Opportunities for Middle School Students of Vocational & Technical Education

To align with the national initiative of promoting high-quality development of occupational education and the implementation of technical-professional education for secondary education policy initiated by the Macau SAR government, last year MGM has inked a letter of intent with Macau Federation of Trade Unions (FAOM) under the support of Education and Youth Affairs Bureau (DSEDJ), to become the first integrated resort operator to promote technical and vocational education with FAOM. This year, the two parties joined hands to roll out the “MGM Youth Development Series – MGM Technical and Vocational Education School – Enterprise Cooperation”, a new program that provide internship learning opportunities for students of Macau Kung Luen Vocational & Technical Middle School.
