Report of Organizational Actions Affecting Basis of Securities

Form 8937 Part II, Box 14:

On April 2, 2019, First Beeville Financial Corporation ("Beeville") completed a merger with Spirit of Texas Bancshares, Inc. ("Spirit"). Pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Agreement and Plan of Merger, dated as of November 27, 2018, Beeville merged with and into Spirit. As a result of the merger, Spirit is the surviving corporation while Beeville ceased to exist as a corporation.

Pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the Reorganization Agreement, each outstanding share of Beeville common stock was converted into the right to receive \$547.45 in cash and approximately 26.7048 shares of Spirit common stock.

In lieu of each fractional share of Spirit Common Stock that would otherwise have been issued to Beeville shareholders in the Merger, Spirit will pay cash in an amount determined by multiplying such fraction by \$19.81.

Form 8937 Part II, Box 15:

The merger of Beeville with and into Spirit qualifies as a tax-free reorganization within the meaning of Section 368(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

A Beeville shareholder's tax basis in one (1) share of Spirit common stock received in exchange for Beeville common stock should equal the shareholder's basis in one (1) share of Beeville common stock divided by 26.7048. Alternatively, such shareholder's tax basis in one (1) share of Spirit common stock received in exchange for Beeville's common stock should equal 3.745% of the shareholder's tax basis in one (1) share of the Beeville common stock.

If a Beeville shareholder acquired different blocks of the Beeville common stock at different times or at different prices, the Spirit common stock received will be allocated pro rata to each block of Beeville common stock, and the basis of each block of Spirit common stock received will be determined on a block-for-block basis depending on the basis of the blocks of Beeville common stock exchanged for such block of Spirit common stock.

Beeville shareholders who receive cash in lieu of a fractional share of Spirit common stock are, for purposes of determining the taxability of that cash, deemed to have received the fractional share in the exchange and then as having sold the fractional share for cash. These Beeville shareholders will generally recognize a taxable gain or loss equal to the difference between the tax basis of the common shares deemed to have been exchanged for the fractional share and the amount of cash received.

Each shareholder is encouraged to consult their own personal tax advisor regarding the determination of this realized gain or loss on the exchange.

Form 8937 Part II, Box 16:

Refer to the description of the basis calculation in Part II, Box 15 above. The April 2, 2019 closing price of a single share of Spirit common stock on the NASDAQ Stock Exchange was \$21.20.

Form 8937 Part II, Box 17:

Spirit's acquisition of Beeville, pursuant to the merger completed on April 2, 2019 was structured to qualify as reorganization within the meaning of Section 368(a) of the Internal Revenue Code. In general, the income tax consequences to the shareholders are determined under Internal Revenue Code sections 302, 354, 356, 358, and 368.

Form 8937 Part II, Box 18:

In general, each Beeville shareholder who received Spirit common stock and cash for all of their Beeville stock cannot recognize any loss. A Beeville shareholder who received cash in lieu of a fractional share of Spirit common stock may recognize loss if the amount of cash received is less than the basis in the fractional share, as applicable.

Form 8937 Part II, Box 19:

In general, any adjustment to the tax basis that causes gain or loss recognized by Beeville shareholder as a result of the completion of the Merger should be reported for the taxable year which includes April 2, 2019. A calendar year shareholder would report the transaction on a 2019 income tax return.

The holding period of Spirit common stock received in exchange for shares of Beeville common stock will include the holding period of Beeville common stock for which it is exchanged. A holder of Beeville common stock who received cash in lieu of a fractional share of Spirit common stock will generally be treated as having received the fractional share pursuant to the merger and then as having sold the fractional share of common stock for cash.

Each shareholder is encouraged to consult their own personal tax advisor regarding the determination of this realized gain or loss on the exchange.

No ruling from the Internal Revenue Service (the "IRS") has been requested, or will be obtained, regarding the U.S. federal income tax consequences of the Merger described in this report. This report is not binding on the IRS and the IRS and the U.S. courts could disagree with one or more of the positions described above.
