WATER STEWARDSHIP POLICY

1. Background & Relevance

Water is a critical resource for human life. As our global population continues to expand and the effects of climate change intensify, governments, companies, and communities alike increasingly need to become even better stewards of water.

Veralto's companies help our customers safeguard precious water resources by helping to address water safety and scarcity, responsible water management, and other water challenges brought on by climate change. We help customers manage, test, treat, and protect our global water supply, from municipal and wastewater treatment facilities to lakes, rivers, watersheds, and oceans. Veralto's innovative solutions help reduce the environmental impact of industrial water, increase efficiency and treat and replenish vital water sources.

We take our water stewardship responsibilities seriously, striving to offer products and services that support our customers' water stewardship activities and goals, and to be responsible water stewards in our own businesses. Veralto and its operating companies engage with external partners and nonprofit organizations as appropriate to advance our shared commitments to solving critical water challenges.

2. Our Commitments

In keeping with our Unifying Purpose of Safeguarding the World's Most Vital Resources™, Veralto is a signatory to the [United Nations Global Compact](#) and supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact. We also support the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, including Goal 6 ("Clean Water and Sanitation").

Veralto and its operating companies are committed to the following water stewardship practices:

In Our Operations: We work to implement operational controls that allow us to quantify our water consumption, itemize its use, and implement water use reduction and recovery practices as appropriate.

In Our Supply Chain: We expect our suppliers and subcontractors to operate in accordance with our [Supplier Code of Conduct](#) and [Sustainable Supply Chain policy](#). Over time, we will incorporate water stewardship considerations in our supplier selection and retention practices and will partner with key suppliers to drive water efficiency in our operations.

In Our Products: We seek opportunities to reduce the volume of water required to manufacture and use our products, to reduce the volume of wastewater they generate, and to reduce the quantity of water necessary for their responsible end-of-life disposal.

In the Community: We work to understand our sites' impact local watersheds, and how the condition of watersheds may in turn impact our operations.

For our Associates: We endeavor to provide access to WASH (water, sanitation, and hygiene) facilities for associates in all our facilities.

3. Regulatory Compliance

In keeping with our [Sustainability](#) and [Environment, Health and Safety \(EHS\)](#) policies, we will monitor our water outflows and effluents, and operate in accordance with applicable permitting, waste management, reporting, and disclosure requirements. We are aware that water resource issues and governance vary by territory and will comply with applicable regulations in all territories where we operate.

4. Management Programs

The VES Water Stewardship tool provides templates and instructions for evaluating current state water risks, water use, identifying opportunities for decreasing water loss, increasing water reuse and recycling, and implementing a comprehensive water stewardship strategy.

Veralto EHS and operations management associates use this Water Stewardship Toolkit and other VES tools as appropriate to support our efforts to minimize our impact on the environment and we are committed to refining these tools over time.

5. Application, Governance, Oversight, and Communication

Application. This Policy applies to Veralto and all of its directly and indirectly controlled subsidiaries worldwide, and each of their respective associates.

Governance. This Policy has been approved by Veralto's President and Chief Executive Officer and Senior Vice President and Chief Legal Officer.

Oversight. Our Board of Directors has delegated to the Nominating and Governance Committee the responsibility of exercising oversight with respect to the Company's sustainability programming and strategy. Consistent with such delegation, management will provide periodic reports and updates to the Nominating and Governance Committee regarding the Company's sustainability program and strategies, including the corresponding risks and opportunities, goals, progress, shareholder engagement and disclosure. Day-to-day management of our sustainability programs is overseen by our Senior Vice President, Strategy and Sustainability. Veralto Corporation's Sr. Vice President and Chief Legal Officer has overall executive-level oversight responsibility for Veralto's EHS program.

Communication. Veralto commits to communicating this Policy to its associates and external stakeholder through Veralto's intranet, external website, annual Sustainability Report and other channels. We also commit to reporting on Veralto's progress and impact with respect to the elements reflected in this Policy in our annual Sustainability Reports.
