

## ZEEKR Intelligent Technology Holding Limited

### Environmental Policy

ZEEKR Intelligent Technology Holding Limited (the “Company”, “Zeekr” or “we”) attaches great importance to progress in global climate change. With climate action and resource conservation as two priorities of our ESG strategies, we are committed to carbon reduction throughout product life-cycle, higher-efficient resource utilization, and enhanced environmental protection, thus contributing to sustainable development goals, and working with stakeholders to build a more resilient zero-carbon ecosystem.

#### 1. Scope of Application

This policy applies to ZEEKR Intelligent Technology Holding Limited and its subsidiaries and branches. Partners, including agents, distributors, independent contractors, contract workers, and suppliers, are expected to act in accordance with this policy and the values it conveys while working with Zeekr.

#### 2. Governance

Zeekr has established ESG governance structure to manage sustainability-related ESG issues, including climate change. The Company’s top management gives priority to the risks and opportunities brought by climate change. Therefore, we invite external experts to collaborate with our professional team to identify climate-related risks and opportunities annually, review our climate strategy and action plans regularly, formulate measurable management objectives and mechanisms, and supervise and guide their implementation.

#### 3. Pledges and Actions

##### Environmental Compliance

Zeekr complies all environmental laws, regulations and standards of countries where it runs its business as applicable. We standardize the treatment, discharge and recycling of solid waste, waste water, waste gas and noise. We further clarify our environmental responsibility and ensure all-round implementation of environmental protection measure, in bid to reduce our adverse impact and improve the environment. Detailed actions include:

- (a) Establish an environment management system in accordance with ISO 14001;
- (b) Identify environmental risks and impacts resulting from raw material procurement, vehicle design, production and manufacturing, transport and delivery, sales, use, end-of-life disposal, and ultimate disposal in accordance with life-cycle management policy; formulate conservation goals to improve environmental protection performance;
- (c) Protect the environment and minimize the potential negative impact of the Company's operations on the environment
- (d) Provide sufficient information and resources required to formulate, monitor and regularly review the Company's environment management policies and objectives;
- (e) Formulate environmental protection policies and standards at least compliant with the law; apply industry best practices to our business operation and services; and
- (f) Conduct regular trainings to raise employees' eco-friendly awareness.

### **Climate Actions**

Zeekr always considers climate change a priority equivalent to its development. We are committed to keeping climate change risks at bay throughout our operation and the value chain, so as to reduce their impact on our business, adapt to climate change, improve our climate resilience, and accelerate our low carbon transition. Detailed actions include:

- (a) Commit to reducing global temperature by 1.5°C in alignment with the Paris Agreement;
- (b) Enhance energy efficiency in business operations by adopting industry best practices; reduce emissions of own operation and achieve full-chain decarbonization across manufacturing, supply, and user ends; halt spending and activities that contribute to the increased use of fossil fuels;
- (c) Assess climate-related physical and transition risks, as well as relevant opportunities; explore how climate change affects business operations and the value chain, including any associated financial risks and opportunities;

- (d) Develop appropriate production processes, measures, and monitoring systems to prevent or reduce the damage that climate change may cause to the Company's existing business; make full use of the opportunities presented by climate change;
- (e) Implement proactive energy management programs that fully consider energy efficiency during product planning, design, production, operation, and sales;
- (f) Prioritize reducing energy demand and enhancing energy efficiency within factories by means of increasing the proportion of clean energy, building PV generation units, electrifying factory equipment, reducing VOC emissions and refrigerant-related carbon emissions, and investing in green technologies and processes; lower energy consumption per vehicle;
- (g) Conduct regular carbon inventory assessment to monitor progress towards carbon management goals, and adjust carbon management guidelines as necessary;
- (h) Disclose climate-related work plans and results from dimensions of governance, strategy, risk management, and metrics and targets on a regular basis.

### **Resource Conservation**

Upholding the concept of nature-positive values, Zeekr urges to develop a circular economy, improves the resource efficiency in manufacturing, and dedicates itself to achieving industry-leading performance on core indicators related to resource conservation in 2025, in order to make nature benefit from business operations.

Detailed actions include:

- (a) Evaluate the impact and dependency of the Company's production and operations on natural resources, and set targets for continuous improvement in performances on resource recycling and waste disposal;
- (b) Adopt a responsible waste management policy, including avoidance of waste generation, waste reduction from the source, and reuse, recycling and responsible disposal of waste, in order to strengthen waste management, regulate waste treatment process, and conduct rational use and proper disposal of waste;
- (c) Encourage the reuse and use of environmentally friendly materials by considering waste reduction (solid wastes, wastewater) in the procurement process as one of

the factors; encourage suppliers to reduce the generation of solid wastes and wastewater and their impacts on the environment wherever feasible by means of reducing, substituting, reusing, recovering and recycling, so as to seize opportunities to promote resource recycling;

- (d) Reduce water consumption through improved technologies and techniques, and adopt technologies, processes and systems that are beneficial to maintain high quality water supply to achieve the desired objectives; and
- (e) Learn risks of water resources at the Zeekr factory and its operation sites, and ensure that the Company's production and operation will not damage or contaminate water sources in the area.

### **Ecosystem Conservation**

Zeekr requires value chain companies to avoid operating near areas containing globally or nationally important biodiversity conservation areas. We make great efforts to eliminate deforestation risks in the supply chain, aiming to achieve zero deforestation, advance biodiversity conservation, and promote harmony between business and nature. Detailed actions include:

- (a) Manage to minimize negative impacts of production and operations on biodiversity and ecosystems, conduct research on animal-free alternatives of leather;
- (b) Fully consider environmental factors in the procurement and selection of suppliers and contractors, and urge suppliers to provide products that are free from any form of illegal deforestation in their supply chains and avoid endangerment or loss of natural forests or highly protected forests; and
- (c) Carry out biodiversity conservation activities in collaboration with users, government agencies, partners and public welfare organizations to develop the "natural-positive" concept with Zeekr characteristics.

#### **4. Cooperation with Stakeholders**

Attaching importance to stakeholder engagement, Zeekr publicizes environmental protection laws and regulations as well as related policies of the Company among the

staff and partners on the entire value chain, and supports trainings on environmental protection, so as to realize our commitment to environmental and natural resource conservation through joint efforts.

- (a) Share our environmental policies and strategies with different stakeholders, and maintain close communication with them, in order to learn their expectations and priorities for the Company on environmental issues;
- (b) Prioritize the requirement that suppliers of components that have an impact on the environment need to pass the ISO 14000 system certification, and prioritize the requirements that special accessories suppliers such as oil products, adhesives, repair tools, and other non-automotive specific products need to pass the ISO 9001 system certification; and
- (c) Encourage stakeholders to do their utmost to reduce carbon emissions, conserve natural resources, and actively participate in non-profit environmental activities in their daily business activities, so as to realize their environmental commitments through concrete actions.

## **6. Other Information**
